Record of Commission Action
June 17, 1982

The June 17, 1982, meeting of the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission was convened in open session by Chairman Nancy Harvey Steorts. Commissioners R. David Pittle, Stuart M. Statler and Sam Zagoria were present. The Commission was briefed on issues relating to the FY 1983 Operating Plan, and considered the following decision matter.

CB Antennas

The Commission voted 3-1 to issue a final Standard for Omnidirectional CB Base Station Antennas, to be effective 180 days after promulgation of the final standard for the industry overall, and to include an exemption procedure of up to 90 days beyond the effective date for small manufacturers and importers. Chairman Steorts and Commissioners Pittle and Statler voted to issue the final standard. Commissioner Zagoria dissented. Commissioner Sloan was not present, but filed a written vote to issue a final standard, thus making this the decision of the Commission by a vote of 4-1.
