Record of Commission Action

At the June 17, 1982, meeting of the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission, Chairman Nancy Harvey Steorts read into the record the following decisions made by ballot vote of the Commissioners.

1. McArthur Enterprises, Inc. CPSC Docket No. 79-2

The Commission by unanimous vote (5-0) accepted a proposed consent agreement and order in the Matter of McArthur Enterprises, Inc., CPSC Docket No. 79-2.

2. Advisory Opinion - Children's Sleepwear

The Commission by unanimous vote (5-0) approved a draft advisory opinion about the effect of the decision in the case of National Knitwear Manufacturers Association v. CPSC on the Commission's enforcement of the flammability standards for children's sleepwear.

3. Regulatory Flexibility Agenda

The Commission by unanimous vote (5-0) approved a Federal Register notice announcing the Commission's semiannual regulatory flexibility agenda.

4. Advance Notice of Proposed Rulemaking - Mattress Flammability Standard Amendment

The Commission by unanimous vote (5-0) approved an advance notice of proposed rulemaking to initiate proceedings for amendment of the mattress flammability standard.
