Record of Commission Action October 28, 1982

The October 28, 1982, meeting of the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission was convened in open session by Chairman Nancy Harvey Steorts. Commissioners Edith Barksdale Sloan, Stuart M. Statler and Sam Zagoria were present. The Commission was briefed by staff on toy chests and a proposed sleepwear enforcement policy, and considered the following decision matter.

Over-the-Counter Antihistamines

The Commission voted unanimously (4-0) to direct the staff to prepare a draft proposed regulation to require special packaging under the Poison Prevention Packaging Act for over-the-counter antihistamines.
