Denial letter and FR Notice regarding Bicycle Manufacturers Association petitions. (CP 73-3 and CP 74-13) (Memo July 2, 1974, to Commissioners from D. Schmeltzer)

DECISION

The Commission decided to deny the Bicycle Manufacturers Association of America's petitions (dated June 14, 1973 and February 25, 1974) requesting that the bicycle regulations be issued under the Consumer Product Safety Act instead of the Federal Hazardous Substances Act. The petitions were denied because the Commission is not aware of persuasive arguments that a risk of injury could not be eliminated to a sufficient extent under FHSA.
