Commissioners Voting by Ballot
Placed in the Record February 17, 1988

At the February 17, 1988, meeting of the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission, the Commission was briefed in open session on Lawn Darts options (decision meeting scheduled for March 2, 1988); and in closed session, the Commission was briefed on Enforcement Matters OS# 5747 and OS# 3726. Also in closed session, the Commission considered Enforcement Matter OS# 5192, which is the subject of a separate Record of Commission Action. No other decisions were made at the meeting.

Chairman Scanlon convened the meeting. Commissioners Carol G. Dawson and Anne Graham were present.

Ballot Vote Decision. The following decision made by ballot vote of the Commissioners was placed in the record.

Draft Letters Concerning Novelty Lighters

The Commission voted unanimously (3-0) to approve, with changes, drafts of letters addressed to five parties involved in the marketing of novelty lighters, and to approve a consumer alert concerning novelty lighters. The draft letters express the Commission's concern about the attractiveness of novelty lighters to children and request assistance in warning consumers that these products should be kept out of the reach of children. Voting to approve the drafts with changes were Chairman Terrence Scanlon and Commissioners Carol Dawson and Anne Graham.
