Family Dollar Inc.; Civil Penalty Settlement \$100,000
(Briefing package dated June 26, 2006, OS No. 5501)

DECISION:

The Commission voted unanimously (3-0) to provisionally accept the Settlement Agreement and Order, which would order Family Dollar, Inc., to pay a civil penalty of \$100,000. The Commission's Office of Compliance staff has negotiated a proposed agreement of \$100,000 to settle the allegations that Family Dollar, Inc., failed to timely report to the Commission a defect in electric blankets it sold. Family Dollar, Inc., violated the reporting requirements of section 15(b) of the Consumer Product Safety Act (CPSA), 15 U.S.C. § 2064(b). The failure to furnish information required by section 15(b) is a prohibited act under section 19(a)(4) of the CPSA, 15 U.S.C. § 2068(a)(4). Section 20(a)(1) of the CPSA, 15 U.S.C. § 2069(a)(1), permits the imposition of civil penalties for any person who knowingly violates section 19 of the CPSA by a company's failure to report information under section 15(b).
