All-Terrain Vehicles (ATVs):

1. Federal Register Notice on ATV Safety Program
2. Arctic Cat Inc.'s Proposed Agreement, Extended Action Plan, and Dealer Monitoring Agreement

DECISION

The Commission voted 2-1 to approve a draft Federal Register notice notifying the public regarding actions that members of the ATV industry have agreed to undertake and requesting public comment (for a period of 45 days) on a proposed Commission Resolution commending the actions of certain members of the ATV industry. Chairman Brown and Commissioner Moore voted to approve the Federal Register notice as drafted. Commissioner Gall voted to approve the Federal Register notice with specified changes that were not adopted.

The Commission voted unanimously (3-0) to approve the proposed Agreement, Extended Action Plan, and Dealer Monitoring Agreement of Arctic Cat Inc. (Arctic Cat chose to negotiate formal accords with the Commission staff regarding its future actions.)
