March 6, 1987


At the March 6, 1987, meeting of the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission, the Commission was briefed by the staff on recent activities of the Gas Heating Systems project. No decisions were made. Chairman Terrence Scanlon convened the meeting. Commissioners Carol G. Dawson and Anne Graham were present.

Ballot Vote Decision: The following decision made by ballot vote of the Commissioners was placed into the record.

Sears Bunk Bed Request--Implementing Letter

The Commission voted 2-0-1 to approve with changes a draft letter implementing a previous decision to deny a request by Sears, Roebuck, and Co. for permission to use the Consumer Product Safety Commission name and logo on a poster and brochure concerning bunk bed hazards. Commissioners Dawson and Graham voted to approve the implementing letter. Chairman Scanlon abstained from voting on the implementing letter because he had dissented from the previous underlying decision.
