ITEM:

OECD Test Guideline No. 496: In vitro Macromolecular Test Method for Identifying Chemicals Inducing Serious Eye Damage and Chemicals Not Requiring Classification for Eye Irritation or Serious Eye Damage
(Briefing package dated July 5, 2023)

Staff recommended that the Commission approve the use of OECD Test Guideline No. 496 as an acceptable method for toxicological testing of consumer products for eye irritation and damage as part of a tiered testing and risk assessment strategy.

DECISION:

The Commission voted unanimously (4-0) to take other action as specified below:

Approve. Staff is authorized to substitute a revised staff memorandum that limits the approval recommendation to the OECD TG 496 test method generally.
