Petition Requesting Rulemaking to Establish Safety Standard for Duster Aerosol Products –
Request for Comments

DECISION:

The Commission voted unanimously (4-0) to approve publication of the draft *Federal Register* notice, to invite public comments for a petition from Families United Against Inhalant Abuse (FUAIA), requesting that the Commission initiate rulemaking to adopt a mandatory safety standard to address the hazards associated with “Duster” aerosol products containing the chemical 1,1-Difluorethane, or any derivative thereof. The petitioner requests that the CPSC safety standard require adding bitterants to dusters, and include a stronger warning on the duster can.
