MINUTES OF COMMISSION MEETING

July 13, 1988

The July 13, 1988, meeting of the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission was convened in open session by Chairman Terrence Scanlon. Commissioners Carol G. Dawson and Anne Graham were present.

Agenda Matters

1. Preliminary 1990 Budget

The Commission was briefed by the staff on the Fiscal Year 1990 preliminary budget request recommended by the Executive Director. No decisions were made. (A decision meeting is scheduled for July 27, 1988.)

2. Lawn Darts - Notice of Proposed Rulemaking

The Commission considered a draft Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (NPR) that would implement the Commission's decision of May 25, 1988, to prohibit the sale of lawn darts that present a risk of skull puncture injuries. Following questions and discussion, the Commission voted 2-0 to approve the NPR as drafted for publication in the Federal Register. Chairman Scanlon and Commissioner Graham voted to approve. Commissioner Dawson did not participate in the vote on the implementing document on the basis that she dissented from the initial decision in this matter.

There being no further business on the agenda, Chairman Scanlon adjourned the meeting.
