Promulgating flammability standards under the FFA

DECISION:

The Commission directs Office of General Counsel to prepare the necessary documents to propose amendments to the Department of Commerce 3-part procedures for the development of standards under the Flammable Fabrics Act. The amendments would eliminate the first step, known as the Notice of Finding that a flammability standard may be needed as a separate step, and combine it with step 2 which involves the publication of the proposed standard for public comment.
