The October 27, 1994, meeting of the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission was convened at 10:00 a.m. in open session by Chairman Ann Brown. Commissioner Mary Sheila Gall was present.

Ballot Vote Decisions. The following decisions made by ballot vote of the Commissioners were placed into the record.

1. Proposed Poison Prevention Packaging Act Requirement for Naproxen
(Ballot due 10/21/94)

The Commission voted unanimously (2-0) to propose a child-resistant (CR) packaging requirement under the Poison Prevention Packaging Act for the anti-inflammatory drug naproxen and to approve with changes a draft Federal Register notice proposing the CR requirement. Commissioner Gall filed a statement concerning her vote in this matter, copy attached.

2. Federal Register Notice Requesting Comment on Petition HP 95-1 for Development of a Safety Standard for Protective Batting Helmets. (Ballot Due 10/25/94)

The Commission voted unanimously (2-0) to approve publication of the draft Federal Register notice requesting comment on new petition HP 95-1, from the Academy of Facial Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery, requesting that the Commission develop a safety standard for protective batting helmets.

Agenda Item: Fiscal Year 1995 Operating Plan

The Commission considered the Operating Plan for Fiscal Year (FY) 1995. The Commission had received a proposed plan from the Executive Director and was briefed by the staff on the plan at the Commission meeting of October 20, 1994. (Ref. briefing package dated October 13, 1994.)

On motion of Chairman Brown, the Commission voted unanimously (2-0) to approve the FY 1995 Operating Plan proposal as presented by the staff in its briefing package of October 13, 1994.

There being no further business on the agenda, Chairman Brown adjourned the meeting.
