ITEM

Proposed Technical Changes to Sleepwear Standard and Clarification of Enforcement Policy

DECISION

The Commission voted 2-0-1 to approve two Federal Register notices concerning the Standards for the Flammability of Children's Sleepwear, Sizes 0 through 6X, and Sizes 7 through 14:

(1) a Federal Register notice proposing three technical changes to the flammability standards for children's sleepwear that would clarify where garment measurements should be taken to determine if they meet the exemption for tight-fitting garments; and

(2) a Federal Register notice proposing a change to the enforcement policy published with the sleepwear standards to clarify that tight-fitting and infant garments may be marketed with traditional flame resistant sleepwear.

Commissioner Gall and Commissioner Moore voted to approve the proposed changes. Chairman Brown abstained.
