Recommended Closing of Flammable Fabrics Case: Ohio
Carpet Distributors, Inc. (carpets) - BCMI #2031

DECISION

This case involves an alleged violation of section 3(a) of the Flammable Fabrics Act on the part of Ohio Carpet Distributors, Inc., a wholesaler and retailer of carpets, by offering and delivering for sale, after receipt in commerce, carpeting which failed to conform to the Standard for the Surface Flammability of Carpets and Rugs (DOC FF 1-70). The case was investigated by staff of the Cleveland Area Office and was forwarded to the Bureau of Compliance (BCM) with Area Office recommendation that the case be closed. BCM, concurring in the recommendation, forwarded the case to the Commission for decision.

Based on recommendation of staff and for reasons given in the above-referenced briefing material, the Commission votes to close the case involving Ohio Carpet Distributors, Inc.
