## **Commissioner Kaye Amendments to the Fall 2017 Regulatory Agenda and Plan**

1. On page 5, in the second full paragraph from the top of the page, strike the phrase: "Following CPSIA direction,"
2. On page 5, in the second full paragraph from the top of the page, strike the phrase: ", according to the timelines provided by the CPSIA."
3. On page 5, at the end of the second full paragraph from the top of the page, add the following: "In addition, there remain major hazard patterns associated with ATVs such as unnecessary instability, access to children, and passengers on ATVs. Staff is conducting additional studies to support an NPRM, including dealing with vehicle stability as required by CPSIA."
