


Request by Ms. Marcia W. Levy of West Hartford, Connecticut, for CPSC Funding to Participate in the November 16, 1977, Oral Presentations Concerning the Proposed Amendments to the Standards for the Flammability of Children's Sleepwear, FF 3-71 and FF 5-74.
