Request from Endo Pharmaceuticals, Inc. for Stay of Enforcement from Special Packaging Requirements for Lidocaine Patch

DECISION

The Commission voted unanimously (3-0) to grant the stay of enforcement requested by Endo Pharmaceuticals, Inc. (Endo) and direct the staff to implement the plan recommended by the Office of Compliance whereby Endo would, by August 1, 2000, use secondary child-resistant packaging for its lidocaine product as an interim measure and develop a plan and schedule for bringing the product into full compliance with the child-resistance requirements for lidocaine preparations. If Compliance does not agree to the plan and schedule for full compliance, it shall so advise the Commission.
