<u>ITEM</u>

Restructuring of the Directorate for Epidemiology by the Chairman, pursuant to section 4(f)(2) of the Consumer Product Safety Act (15 U.S.C. 2053(f)(2)).

DECISION

Based on the recommendation of the Chairman and after discussion and consultation in accordance with section 4(f)(2) of the Consumer Product Safety Act, Section 4 of the Commission's General Policies, and the Commission's Policy on Notification, the Commission hereby approves the restructuring of the Directorate for Epidemiology to include the following changes: (1) abolish the vacant position of Associate Executive Director for Epidemiology; (2) combine the Directorate for Epidemiology, consisting of the Division of Hazard Analysis and the Division of Hazard and Injury Data Systems, with the Directorate for Health Sciences to create the Directorate for Epidemiology and Health Sciences; (3) reassign the Division of the National Injury Information Clearinghouse to the Office of Information Services; and (4) reassign the Division of Human Factors to the Directorate for Engineering.
