Subpoena to Techtronic Industries of North America, Inc.
(Briefing package dated January 23, 2008, OS No. 3482)

DECISION:

The Commission voted unanimously (2-0) to issue the Special Order and Subpoena to Techtronic Industries of North America, Inc., requiring by subpoena the attendance and testimony of witnesses and the production of all documentary evidence relating to the execution of its duties pursuant to section 27(b)(3) of the Consumer Product Safety Act ("CPSA"), 15 U.S.C. § 2076(b)(3). The Commission also voted unanimously (2-0) to authorize William J. Moore, or such other person designated by the Assistant Executive Director for Compliance and Field Operations, to take the depositions with the power to administer oaths, ordered by the Special Order and Subpoena, pursuant to Section 27(b)(4) of the CPSA, 15 U.S.C. § 2076(b)(4). The information or documents are for the Office of Compliance and Field Operations staff investigation of the potential hazard posed by battery chargers for cordless power drills and the possible defect reporting or timeliness violations, pursuant to Section 15(b) of the CPSA. The Compliance staff asked the Commission to issue a special order and subpoena to the firm for documentation, answers to questions and testimony of witnesses in furtherance to the staff's investigation.
