Update to Statement of Interpretation and Enforcement Policy Regarding Labeling of Household Products Containing Methylene Chloride; Supplemental Guidance
(Briefing package dated March 7, 2018, OS No. 3206)

DECISION:

The Commission voted unanimously (4-0) to approve publication of the draft *Federal Register* notice that would update the 1987 Statement to address labeling for acute hazards from inhaling methylene chloride vapors from paint strippers. The update responds to a petition from the Halogenated Solvents Industry Alliance, Inc. asking the Commission to amend the agency's 1987 Statement of Interpretation and Enforcement Policy regarding labeling of household products containing methylene chloride vapors.
