Arthur Lee is the chair for this working group (WG) that the UL 507 Technical Committee (TC) suggested be formed to create similar thermal aging requirements for motors in the motor standard as the TC developed for the fan standard (UL 507)

The WG members discussed a draft proposal for UL 1004 (motors) to include oven aging conditioning requirements for motors used in unattended applications.
