SUMMARY OF MEETING:

The TC 1026/982 TG is developing requirements for appliance safety standards for the emerging technology of wireless power transfer to cordless kitchen appliances. During this meeting, the group revisited clause 19.13, reviewing whether no transmission was permitted as one of the test criteria. The group decided to modify the requirement such that intentional transmissions, such as communication between the source and load, were acceptable. New phrasing was drafted to address this, noting unintentional and power transmissions were not permitted.

The TG agreed that no modifications to Part 1 Clauses 19.14, 19.15 and 19.16 were needed. The TG started to discuss Clause 19.101 and will pick up from there at the next meeting.
