Interagency Agreement (IAG)  
between the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC)  
and the Federal Law Enforcement Training Center

1. Project Title: Introduction to Criminal Investigation Training Program (ICITP)

2. Description of Services: The servicing agency, Federal Law Enforcement Training Center, shall present a training course to the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission Office of Field Investigations investigators designed to acquaint the non-criminal federal government regulatory investigator with a federal criminal investigation. The class is ICITP M-101. The contractor shall:

- a. Present a four day training course that covers the procedures, techniques, legal concerns, and general issues associated with criminal investigations. Class schedule is from October 25-28, 2010. Lodging will be from 10/24 – 10/29/2010 for 24 students.
- b. Designed for the non criminal federal government regulatory investigator, the course shall focus on basic criminal investigative issues such as interviewing skills and federal law requirements.
- c. The course will combine classroom lectures and practical exercises allowing students to better comprehend the various investigative procedures.
- d. The course shall be taught at the Federal Law Enforcement Training Center in Glynco, Georgia.

3. Statement of Work

- a. Background and Purpose: The U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) Office of Compliance and Field Operations employs approximately 100 field investigators. The Consumer Product Safety Improvement Act of 2008 included substantially increased civil and criminal penalties for prohibited acts enforced by the CPSC. As a result, the field investigators expect to see an increase in their involvement in the development of criminal cases leading to criminal indictment and federal prosecution. While many of the investigators are former local, state or federal law enforcement officers, others have no criminal investigative experience. This is a training area that the CPSC would like to focus on directly.
- b. Objective: The objective of the course is to acquaint the non-criminal federal government investigator/ student with the procedures, techniques, legal concerns, and general issues associated with federal criminal investigations.

4. Government (CPSC) provided materials/equipment:

- a. All furnished equipment/materials: The Federal Law Enforcement Training Center, Glynco, Georgia will provide all equipment/materials.

5. Period of Performance:

a. Agreement: This agreement shall remain in effect from the date of signature by both parties and shall remain in effect indefinitely until terminated by either party. Section 3(a) describes the purpose of the entire agreement.

b. Funding: Funding is provided using FY10 funds for the course with a period of performance for October 24-29 due to this being a Bona fide need for the Commission. Funding in the amount of \$13,000 is provided for this course, meals and lodging. The specific work to be performed, reports and deliverables for this course as described above in this agreement.

6. Modification and cancellation: This agreement may be modified by mutual consent of both parties or canceled upon 30 days advance written notice by either party.

7. Resolution of Disagreements: In the event that the CPSC and the Federal Law Enforcement Training Center have a disagreement arising under this Interagency Agreement, then the parties shall cooperatively seek to resolve the disagreement by themselves. If the disagreement cannot be resolved between them, then the parties agree to seek the assistance of a third party in resolving the disagreement.

Section 27(g) of the Consumer Product Safety Act, 15 U.S.C. 2076(g)
