Dear Mr. Collier:

This letter is in response to your January 28, 1974, request for a "variation" from the requirements of the full-size crib regulations published November 21, 1973 (38 F.R. 32129), for your product, the "[redacted]"

An evaluation of your request revealed that the [redacted] interior width is only 20 inches. This is 5-3/8 inches less than the width necessary for a crib to be considered a "full-size baby crib" as defined in section 1508.1(a) of the regulations. Since the [redacted] does not meet the definition of a "full-size baby crib," it is not subject to the regulations, and a variation is therefore not necessary.
