SUMMARY OF MEETING:

WCMA representatives described the solutions to make window coverings safer such as cordless, single retractable cord, clutch with restraining device, cord lock, clutch with tension device, and motorization and identified the current applicability of these solutions for major window coverings. They identified the challenges with certain technologies including usability of the product by elderly, reach restrictions of short statured people and maximum force requirements to operate the product.
