Dear Mr. [REDACTED]:

This letter is in reply to your correspondence of February 21, 1974, in which you requested that the Consumer Product Safety Commission advise you as to whether "[REDACTED]" a type of hanger hook sold by one of your clients, complies with the Consumer Product Safety Act. The reason for this request is that your client's insurance company has asked for a statement that the advertising material accurately describes the product and its performance and complies with the Consumer Product Safety Act.

We are unable to offer any advice in regard to the insurance company's request for a statement that the advertising material accurately describes the product and its performance.

Insofar as a statement that the product complies with the Consumer Product Safety Act is concerned, although the Commission may promulgate consumer product safety standards for consumer products, it has not promulgated any standard applicable to "[REDACTED]" as of this date. Thus, there is no regulation under the Consumer Product Safety Act pertaining to the advertising material which accompanies this particular product.
