ITEM:

- (1) Formation of a Chronic Hazard Advisory Panel (CHAP) for Phthalates
- (2) Fiscal Year 1999 Funds to Perform Child Observation (Mouthing) Study

DECISION:

The Commission voted unanimously (3-0) to direct the staff to begin the process of forming a Chronic Hazard Advisory Panel (CHAP) to evaluate chronic hazards of diisononyl phthalate (DINP) in children's products made of polyvinyl chloride (PVC). The Commission also voted unanimously (3-0) to reprogram specified FY 1999 funds to conduct a child observation study to estimate the time children spend mouthing products that might contain phthalates. (Ref: Staff memorandum dated December 8, 1998.)
