Wednesday January 12, 2011

Play yards/Non-full-size Cribs

Review of the new proposed requirements, in an attempt to get it out to ballot by the end of the month, so that there will be a revised standard on June 1, 2011.

Bedside Sleeper

Reviewed the draft standard and made several modifications. The latest draft will be cleaned up and presented to the task group for a conference call on Jan 18th. The standard must go out to ballot before the end of the month to meet the schedule for a published standard on June 1st, 2011.

Hammocks

Task group is looking the draft standard and continuing to develop any needed testing requirements and also evaluating the current protocols.

Strollers

Task Group Review - Reviewing the proposed requirements for saddle hinge and canopy hinge pinch points.

Stroller with Car Seat –Deals with frames when combined with a car seat, make a stroller. Draft requirements reviewed. Will effect scope, definitions, and requirements/procedures. Will go out to ballot.

Stability (Child Climbing In) – Deals with strollers that have rotating seats, makes it harder to test. A new draft requirement was reviewed and voted to be sent out to ballot.

Reviewed the CPSC data and staff's identification of hazards that may not be adequately addressed. Task group to form to address these concerns.

Thursday January 13, 2011

Bed Rails

Staff reviewed a draft proposed requirements to address mis-assembly and mis-installation. In addition, two prototypes of bedrails that would meet the requirements and also can be packaged small where demonstrated.

Swings

Review the ballot item - revision to 3.1.11 (Adding a definition of a travel swing) and 8.3.1 (changing the word children to infant, changing seat belt to restraint system, and added two new warnings dealing with the adjustable seat recline use and travel swing use). The ballot period was not quite over, so more comments/negatives might come in.

Hand Held Carriers

(Restraint System) to address this.
