Advance Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (ANPR) – Possible Revocation or Amendment of Mattress/Mattress Pad Flammability Standard at 16 CFR 1632 (Briefing package dated June 6, 2005, OS No. 4830)

DECISION:

The Commission voted unanimously (3-0) to approve the draft ANPR notice for the *Federal Register* concerning the Commission's existing mattress and mattress pad flammability standard at 16 CFR 1632. In response to the proposed rule published on January 13, 2005, that contains a test for open flame ignition of mattresses, the Commission received comments suggesting that once the new standard is in effect, the existing standard may no longer be necessary and would be burdensome. The draft ANPR will begin the process of examining the need for continuing the existing standard with its cigarette ignition test.
