MEETING SUMMARY: The International Sleep Products Association representatives requested to meet with Commissioner Adler to discuss their comments submitted for the record regarding the Commission's Notice of Accreditation for Third Party Conformity Assessment Bodies to test for 16 CFR parts 1632 and 1633. The representatives provided Commissioner Adler with information regarding their existing compliance with the flammable fabrics regulations, including their members' current use of third party labs that are or are expected to be CPSC accredited. Additional issues discussed included lab capacity and challenges the mattress manufacturing industry faces in relation to compliance with mandatory third party testing. Commissioner Adler thanked the representatives for submitting comments for the public record and taking the time to provide him with additional information.
