SUBJECT: Meeting with Go Mama Go Designs (GMDG)

ATTENDEES: Catherine Hall, Principal/Director of Sales, GMDG; Georgia Fiebrich, Principal/Director of Operations, GMDG; and Christopher Junker, M.D., Critical Care Medicine, Medical Facility Associates – The George Washington University.

CPSC ATTENDEES: Robert Adler, Commissioner; Jason K. Levine, Chief Counsel to Commissioner Adler; Jana Fong-Swamidoss, Senior Counsel to Commissioner Adler; and Elliot Kaye, Senior Counsel to Chairman Tenenbaum.

MEETING SUMMARY: In light of Maryland's proposed ban of crib bumpers and Chicago's ordinance that prevents the sale of crib bumpers, representatives from Go Mama Go Designs requested a meeting with Commissioner Adler to discuss their product, Wonder Bumpers. They provided Commissioner Adler with an overview of the safety features of their vertical rail guards, including a study they commissioned analyzing the potential carbon dioxide dispersal rates in a crib when a Wonder Bumper is in use. The representatives expressed concern regarding public perception that all crib bumpers are unsafe and expressed a desire to work with the Commission on any safety messages the Commission may issue regarding crib bumpers. Commissioner Adler thanked the representatives for taking the time to meet with him and encouraged them to continue working with the Commission and CPSC staff.
