**STATEMENT OF COMMISSIONER MARY SHEILA GALL  
REGARDING THE BALLOT VOTE  
RECOMMENDING THAT THE COMMISSION APPROVE  
A RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING BOMBARDIER INC.  
FOR ITS ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE SAFETY-RELATED ACTIONS  
MARCH 19, 1999**

Consistent with my prior vote on whether the Commission should issue a Resolution commending companies for agreeing to undertake comparable ATV safety-related activities, I abstain. It is inappropriate to commend only certain companies and not recognize others who have worked diligently to develop substantial ATV safety programs in the spirit of the former ATV consent decree.
