SUMMARY OF MEETING: During the course of lunch Mr. Cladouhos mentioned the expiration of the 1988 Consent Decree between the Commission and the Department of Justice on the one hand, and the ATV manufacturers on the other. Mr. Wilson said that he believed that the Commission staff would contact the ATV manufacturers and other interested parties sometime during the early part of 1997 to discuss possible extension and/or modification of the Consent Decree.
