Chairman Brown outlined her priorities and agenda for CPSC and invited inquiries and suggestions from the consumer representatives. The group covered a broad range of issues and urged the Chairman to work with and stay in contact with consumer advocacy groups and state and local agencies on these issues.

Two examples of the kind of suggestions offered were:

National Association of Consumer Agency Administrators:

Would like to explore ways they could be of assistance to CPSC. They have 150 member offices around the country, and would like to assist us in publicizing recalls, helping with compliance, etc. Local and state consumer protection officials stressed importance of getting recall information to public more effectively and their support for efforts to get media to pay more attention to recalls.

Safe Kids: Would be interested in working with us on a couple of issues, including carbon monoxide detectors; and effort to promote summer camp safety on subjects such as ATVs, bicycle safety, etc.
