The representative updated the CPSC staff on Ciba activities on child-resistant issues since the comment period for the proposal ended. Ciba discussed issues related to packaging for dibucaine creams including the lack of a defined dose, partial usage of "unit packaging," unsuitability of jars for hemorrhoidal relief products. The meeting was then closed and the company shared some data with the Commission staff and discussed future plans.
