SUMMARY OF MEETING: ALA representatives gave a brief background of their membership and then began discussing the need for an amendment to the CPSIA to exempt older books from the retroactive lead testing requirements. CPSC representatives pointed out a proposed amendment to the CPSIA that would have exempted books but failed to pass through Congress. The ALA representatives also asked for the agency to draft guidance for their members that would exempt

older books from the lead testing requirements.
