## ORDER GRANTING UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO MOVE TO QUASH OR LIMIT SUBPOENA

On January 29, 2014, non-party Julie Teicher, trustee of the Maxfield and Oberton Holdings, LLC Liquidating Trust, filed an Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time to Move to Quash or Limit Subpoena (Motion). In the Motion, Ms. Teicher argues that as a result of the complexity of the underlying issues, ongoing negotiations, and the voluminous documents requested, she will need additional time in which to file a motion to quash or limit the CPSC subpoena.

The applicable regulations provide only five (5) days for the person to whom a subpoena is directed to file a motion to quash or limit the subpoena. 16 C.F.R. § 1025.38(g). Due to this short time frame, and in light of the fact that the Motion is

unopposed, Ms. Teicher shall have an additional thirty (30) days, <u>until Friday</u>, <u>February 28, 2014</u>, in which to file a motion to quash or limit the CPSC subpoena.

## WHEREFORE,

Non-Party Julie Teicher's Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time to Move to Quash or Limit Subpoena is hereby **GRANTED.**
