**ORDER GRANTING RESPONDENTS' APPLICATION FOR LEAVE TO TAKE
DEPOSITIONS
AND
ORDER REGARDING COMPLAINT COUNSEL'S JUNE 27, 2014 FILING**

On June 27, 2014, Counsel for Respondents Zen Magnets, LLC and Star Networks USA, LLC filed an Unopposed Application for Leave to Take Depositions (Application). 16 C.F.R. § 1025.35. In the Application, Counsel sought leave to depose the following people: Jonathan Midgett, Ph.D., Kathleen Stralka, M.S., Gregory Rodgers, Joseph J. Martyak, Vincent J. Amodeo, J. Paul Frantz, Ph.D., C.P.S.M., CPE, Laurence Steinberg, Ph.D., and R. Adam Noel, M.D. Counsel indicated the Consumer Product Safety Commission does not object to Respondents taking the depositions of the aforementioned individuals.¹

¹ Pursuant to the undersigned's June 20, 2014 Memorandum of Pre-Hearing Conference and Scheduling Order, the parties need not bring an application for leave to take depositions to the undersigned unless there is a dispute as to particular deponents.

Also on June 27, 2014, Complaint Counsel filed a Response to June 18, 2014 Order Regarding Pending Subpoena Request and Joint Report Regarding Stipulated Depositions and Use of Documents Produced in Docket 12-1 (Response and Report). The Response and Report indicated the parties jointly stipulated to depositions for various individuals, including all the individuals listed in Respondents' Application. The filing further noted Complaint Counsel no longer seeks to depose Dr. Carol Pollack-Nelson and stated the parties have stipulated they may use documents produced in Docket 12-1 in discovery, but retain all objections.

WHEREFORE,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT the request for leave to take depositions of all individuals listed in the June 27, 2014 Response and Report is hereby **GRANTED**.
