**ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE AMENDED
COMPLAINT AND SUPPLEMENTAL MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE
AMENDED COMPLAINT FOR CPSC DOCKET NO. 12-1**

On September 18, 2012, counsel for the Consumer Product Safety Commission (“CPSC” or “Agency”) filed a Motion for Leave to File Amended Complaint for CPSC Docket No. 12-1. Subsequently, on September 24, 2012, the Agency filed a Supplemental Motion for Leave to File Amended Complaint. The latter Motion explained that the Agency sought only “...to attach to the Amended Complaint a List and Summary of Documentary Evidence.”

Both Motions were filed with Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Bruce T. Smith, the ALJ to whom the matter was initially assigned.¹ Maxfield and Oberton Holdings, LLC did not respond to either Motion. The undersigned finds the amended pleadings will not unduly broaden the issues or cause undue delay. 16 C.F.R. § 1025.13.

WHEREFORE,
