# SCHEDULING ORDER FOR RESPONDENTS TO RESPOND TO AGENCY'S MOTION TO CONSOLIDATE CPSC DOCKET NUMBERS 12-1/12-2 AND 13-2

On December 17, 2012, counsel for the Consumer Product Safety Commission ("CPSC" or "Agency") filed a Motion to Consolidate CPSC Docket Nos. 12-1/12-2 (<u>In re Maxfield and Oberton Holdings, LLC/In re Zen Magnets, LLC</u>) with CPSC Docket No. 13-2 (<u>In re Star Networks USA, LLC</u>). Agency counsel served the Motion to Consolidate on all Respondents.

On October 30, 2012, I issued an order consolidating CPSC Docket Nos. 12-1 and 12-2 in my capacity as Acting Chief Administration Law Judge because the cases had been assigned to two different presiding judges. That order assigned the consolidated cases to the Hon. Dean C. Metry.

However, due to the unique procedural posture of these cases and my rendering the earlier decision on consolidating CPSC Docket Nos. 12-1 and 12-2, I am modifying the time for Respondents to file a response as outlined below.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Respondents shall have ten (10) days from the service of this Order to respond to the Motion to Consolidate CPSC Docket No. 13-2 with CPSC Docket Nos. 12-1 and 12-2.
