ORDERED that Respondent Amazon.com, Inc. (“Amazon”) is, as a matter of law, a “distributor” of the Subject Products identified in the Complaint and sold through the Fulfillment by Amazon program, as set forth in the Consumer Product Safety Act (“CPSA”), as amended, 15 U.S.C. § 2051 *et seq.*

The case shall proceed on the remaining issues, including whether the Subject Products present a substantial product hazard and, if so, what remedial actions Amazon must take, as a distributor of the Subject Products, to protect the public.
