**ORDER SHORTENING THE TIME FOR ANY OPPOSITION
TO AMAZON.COM, INC.’S MOTION TO STAY**

In a letter dated August 1, 2024, Amazon.com, Inc. requested that the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission (Commission) (1) stay any and all portions of its July 30, 2024 Decision and Order that are deemed to be final while Amazon attempts to negotiate a Proposed Notification Plan and Proposed Action Plan with Complaint Counsel, and (2) stay any forthcoming order on the Proposed Notification Plan and Proposed Action Plan once issued, pending judicial review. The Commission has deemed Amazon’s letter to be a motion under the Commission’s regulation at 16 C.F.R. § 1025.23. Pursuant to 16 C.F.R. § 1025.23(c), the Commission has designated three days from issuance of this Order for receipt of any opposition to Amazon’s motion. There shall be no reply to any response filed by Complaint Counsel. *Id.*

The schedule for drafting and submitting the Proposed Notification Plan and Proposed Action Plan contained in the Decision and Order remains unchanged, pending the Commission’s resolution of Amazon’s motion.

IT IS ORDERED that any opposition to Amazon’s motion shall be due on August 9, 2024.
