## KEEP BABY SAFE IN PLAY YARD SPACE

Starting February 28, 2013, testing for play yards will be more rigorous. Play yards that meet new safety standards must have:

Side rails that resist forming a sharp V when folded to prevent strangulation

> Stronger corner brackets to prevent sharp-edged cracks and side rail collapse

## **SAFE SLEEP TIPS:**

- Always place baby on back to sleep.
- Only use the mattress sold with the play yard.
- Keep pillows, quilts, comforters, and cushions out of play yards, cribs, and bassinets.
- Dress baby in footed pajamas for warmth.

A play yard is a framed enclosure with a floor and mesh or fabric side panels. It may be folded for storage or travel. It is primarily intended to provide a play or sleeping environment for children who are less than 35 inches tall who cannot climb out of the product. Sturdier mattress attachments to the play yard floor to prevent entrapments and injuries





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
